Year 4-12 student scholarships—The Department of Education and Training manages a number of scholarships which are available to students who are currently enrolled in Years 4-12.

Applicants for these scholarships are evaluated on their:

- \* participation in school activities
- \* community involvement
- \* academic record for the current year.

Scholarships are either one-off payments or for the duration of the student's course/study annually.

Pre-school children will visit the school and become familiar with some of the staff, areas and equipment. Kinder staff bring children to the school for a 9.00am start and pick them up at 1.00pm to return to the kindergarten.

*Children who have not attended pre-school but are eligible to commence primary school in 2022 are most welcome to participate in this transition program. 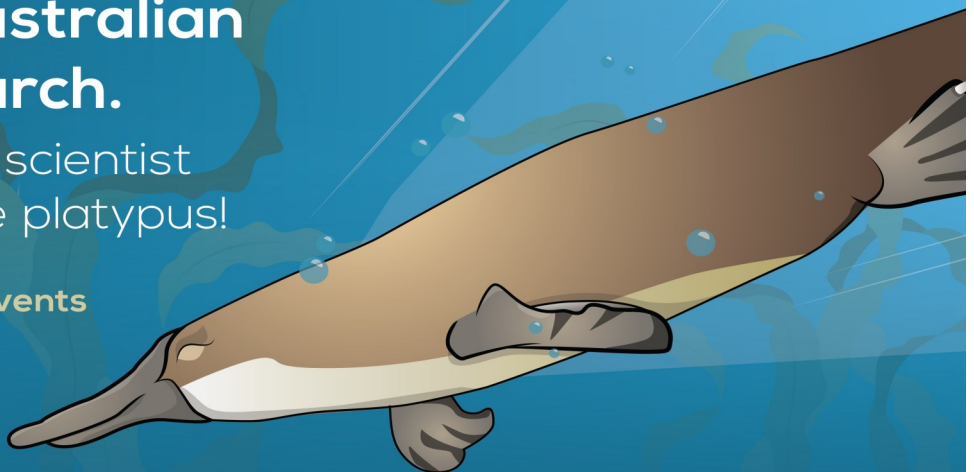
